

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS – CDBG-I PROJECT
Woodland, North Carolina
Sewer Collection System Improvements

Separate sealed bids for the Town of Woodland for Sewer Collection System Improvements – 19-I-3116 will be received at the office of the Town Hall located at 123 E. Main Street, Woodland, NC 27897 on Tuesday, December 7th, 2021 until 2:00 PM, then at said office to be publicly opened and read aloud. The bidder shall show such evidence by clearly displaying his or her current license number on the outside of the sealed envelope in which the proposal is delivered.

Bids must be submitted on the complete project. Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, addressed to the Town of Woodland, P.O. Box 297, 123 E. Main Street, Woodland, NC 27897 and the outside of the envelope must be marked “Bid for Sewer Collection System Improvements – 19-I-3116”. All bids must be made on blank forms provided and included in the bound document. The name, address, and license number with limitation and classification of the Bidder must be plainly marked thereon.

Contractors are notified that North Carolina G.S. 87 relating to licensing of contractors will be observed in receiving bids and awarding contracts.

The project consists of replacing the existing 300 gpm pump/lift station with a new pump/lift station of the same capacity on the same site. The new pump/lift station will include a new precast concrete wet well with pre-fabricated enclosure with suction lift pumps, new electrical and control panels, new telemetry, and a new emergency generator. A manual bar screen in a precast concrete vault will also be constructed upstream of the wet well. The project will also include installing two (2) new manholes and associated gravity lines to redirect flow to the new wet well and replacing the existing two (2) automatic air release valves on the force main to the wastewater treatment plant.

Bona fide bidders who return full sets of the Bidding Documents in good condition (suitable for re-use) within 10 days after receipt of Bids will receive a full refund. An additional electronic (.pdf) version of plans and specifications may be purchased for an additional \$35.00 non-refundable fee. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to “Rivers & Associates, Inc.”. Upon request and receipt of the document deposit indicated above, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder’s date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held at the Town Hall located at 123 E. Main Street, Woodland, NC 27897 on Monday, November 22nd, 2021 at 2:00 PM. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory. In accordance with the Minority Participation Goals, potential prime Contractor(s), should attend the Pre-Bid Conference.
